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

**Subject: Reimbursement of medicines to RECHS Members/ Beneficiaries for 5 days at the time of discharge after hospitalization.**

Instances have been brought to notice by Units that many RECHS Members/ Beneficiaries are not getting medicines from the Hospitals at the time of discharge which have been prescribed in the discharge summary/ by Doctor. Therefore, whether the medicines purchased from open market under such circumstances are reimbursable to RECHS Members/ Beneficiaries?

It is clarified as per Rule 20 of BHEL RECHS Rules that medicines prescribed in the discharge summary/ by Doctor at the time of discharge and purchased from open market are reimbursable to RECHS Members/ Beneficiaries to the extent of five days only. The intent behind permitting medicines for initial five days is that it may not be possible for the RECHS Members/ Beneficiaries / family members to visit BHEL hospital/ dispensary immediately on discharge
