Sub: Amendment in BHEL Retired Employees Contributory Health Scheme regarding admissibility of medical insurance cover

Kindly refer to Corporate HR Circular No.026 dated 08.12.2016 on the above subject.

As per para 3.2 of the extant provisions, "Retired employees can avail medical treatment through medical insurance cover as well as under BHEL RECH scheme provided entire bill (in original) for the single hospitalisation, is settled by either of the source".

Requests have been received from Units for reviewing the condition to enable retired employees claim reimbursement of medical treatment through medical insurance cover.

Accordingly, para 3.2 of BHEL Retired Employees' Contributory Health Scheme stands revised as under:

"Retired employee/spouse having medical insurance cover may avail benefits under this scheme provided the entire bill (in original), giving itemised details for the single hospitalisation is submitted to BHEL for reimbursement in the first instance."

This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
