1. Eligibility for Membership

15 yrs of continuous service in CPSEs made a prerequisite for being eligible for Membership under RECHS.

2. Registration/ Annual Revalidation under RECHS

Facility of online registration / Annual Revalidation under RECHS introduced. Annual revalidation could be done online from 1st Jan to 28th 29th of Feb every year.
